

Phase 3: June 26

Hours of operation: Monday—Sunday 9am-9pm
(Hours will be Weather Dependent)

The Lake and South Beach Area:

Open to OAH Members only—**no guests are allowed at this time.**

At this time we are only allowing 100 people in the park/lake area at a time**per AHS regarding group gatherings.

Swimming is permitted in designated areas.

Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, AHS has suspended all natural recreational water sampling for beaches in Alberta until further notice. AHS labs are unable to test any samples at this time. OAH has undertaken the task using a private company to test the water during swimming season this year. This recreational water sampling service will comprise of weekly sampling for Escherichia coli testing, as well as monitoring for presence/absence of cyanobacteria. Testing includes sampling, analyses and results reporting. If there is ever an issue, information will be provided to members within a day of testing and the lake will be closed for treatment.

Number of members on the beach area is limited to given the size of the beach area while ensuring social distancing protocols are met.

No guests are permitted at this time, however with spaces being limited on the beach area we encourage Resident Cohort families to share a marked area on the beach.

When the amenity is busy and/or at capacity please limit your time on the beach to 3 hours so that other members have the opportunity to use the amenity.

Gathering areas are demarked on the beach area and each area will accommodate 1 family and 1 resident cohort family only.

Sentinel Security will provide monitoring services. Any members that are found to be in breach of the regulations will be asked to leave the area.

No fishing is allowed for the 2020 season.

Boating:

Canoes, kayaks, SUP will be permitted on the lake. No water toys (i.e.floaties, water trampolines, noodles, etc.) will be permitted on the water.

Life jackets are mandatory for any patrons using these devices. Please ensure you bring your own, there are no rentals or exceptions.

Members are expected to remain in/on their boats to the best of their abilities at all times.

Members are limited to 3 hours on the water to allow all members the opportunity to enjoy the lake.

Social distancing requirements must be adhered to.

Swimming is permitted in designated areas.

Dock South Beach Area:

Only one family is allowed on the dock at any given time. Physical distancing protocols must be adhered to at all times.

Members please ensure you are entering/exiting the dock area to launch your boat as quickly as possible so that the next member may do the same. No loitering/congregating on the dock.

Social distancing requirements must be adhered to.

Members are limited to 3 hours on the water when the amenity is busy or at capacity to allow all members the opportunity to enjoy the lake.

No diving or swimming is allowed.

Fire Pit:

One household and their resident cohort family may use the Fire Pit at a time. You must bring your own firewood. No burning of old pallets or garbage is permitted.

No guests are permitted.

Picnic Tables:

One household and their resident cohort family may use picnic tables at a time. Please limit use to 1 hour and inform security when you are finished using them so that they may be sanitized for the next use.

Washroom Facilities:

Washroom facilities are on site, sanitizer is provided and we ask that the facilities be sprayed down after each use. Additional hand sanitization stations are available.

Walkways and Leisure Areas:

The walkways and grassed areas are open to members only. Please no congregating. Social distancing requirements must be adhered to.

Progression to the next phase is dependent on the success and adherence to the first phase and guidance from all regulatory bodies.
