

December 17 2020 Adventure Zone Update:

"This Friday, December 18, the Harmony Adventure Park Phase 1 is opening for the first time. This facility, currently held and managed by Harmony Developments Inc. (HDI) and operated by the Owners Association of Harmony (OAH), will be available to Harmony members only at this time to ensure compliance with the AHS social gathering restrictions. It will become available to Harmony member guests in the New Year once social gathering restrictions are lifted, and a separate notice will be provided.

The following facilities will be available for Harmony members, with COVID protocols in place:

- Skating rink (with temporary lighting off of Discovery Centre)
- Skating ribbon
- Toboggan hill
- Skateboard park (weather permitting)
- Discovery Centre parking lot

Please note:

- Fire pit is not available at this time in order to avoid social gathering
- The Discovery Centre will <u>not</u> be open and will be unavailable to the residents due to Covid safety precautions

Other areas of the Adventure Park Phase 1 will open in Summer 2021, including the dog park, off leash area, dog park pond, pump track, and climbing wall. These areas are not fully complete and require full grow-in to occur before we open them. **HDI asks that you not venture into these areas until further messaging is sent saying that they are open for use.**

The Adventure Park will be monitored. Random check-ins will be performed by Sentinel Security throughout the week and weekends. We ask that when you visit the Adventure Park to bring your OAH Member Card with you, and show it to any OAH staff or Sentinel when asked. This is the same card you use to gain access to the south beach area, and if you do not have it, you will be asked to leave and return with it. If you do not have a card, please contact admin@harmonyowners.ca.

Temporary lighting has been installed on the Discovery Centre to light the skating rink. These lights are very bright to ensure the area is well lit for member safety. The lighting will be on a timer and will turn off at 9:30 pm.

These amenities are able to be open **provided that users follow all AHS guidelines and restrictions**. We ask that **all community members self-govern and self-regulate** to ensure your safety and the safety and welfare of fellow community members is maintained.



As a community, work together to adhere to all the current AHS COVID protocols so that continued access to this amenity is possible for your enjoyment. *If community members do not follow the Covid-19 protocols listed below, the Adventure Park will need to be shut down.* Please cooperate and listen to any OAH staff or their agents in this regard. Thank you.

COVID – 19 Rules (subject to change at any time)

- No guests outside home occupants are permitted to use the amenity at this time
- Masks are mandatory in the park
- Please skate in one direction on the Skating Ribbon to help maintain distance
- Please do not leave personal belongings on or around seating or other communal areas
- No hockey is allowed. Do not bring sticks or pucks into the skating rink or ribbon areas
- The Discovery Centre is not currently available for bathrooms or beverages. Please make your own arrangements.
- Fire pit is not available in order to avoid gathering
- Park will be monitored by OAH staff and security

Maximum capacity in the park:

- Skating Rink 10 skaters with masks
- Skating Ribbon Please maintain 2-3 m distance from other groups and wear a mask

Please help us in preventing the spread of COVID-19 and maintain 2 meters of physical distance and avoid any social gatherings at this time.

Adventure Park Rules:

This area is currently accessible to members and their household only

- Hours of Operation: 9am to 9pm, Monday-Sunday
- Visitors must have a valid OAH Member Card (or Visitor pass) to enter the park
- Homeowners must be familiar with and observe all OAH Rules & Regulations full details are available at HarmonyOwners.com
- If you do not present your OAH Member Card when asked, you will be asked leave the park and return with it.

GENERAL RULES

To ensure that members enjoy their time at the park, rules for the area include:

- Obey all signage in the park
- Be respectful: this park is for all ages and skill levels
- Aggressive language or behaviour towards others (staff and other guests) will not be tolerated
- No alcohol, smoking material, or drugs are permitted within the park
- Please keep our park clean and put your garbage in the cans provided
- Safety equipment is strongly recommended
- This park is not supervised by HDI or the OAH and therefore use is at your own risk
- No motorized vehicles are allowed within the park
- Members are responsible for guests and their behaviour
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver
- The Owners Association of Harmony, the Developer and any associated partners are not responsible for any injury or damage from park use at any time

SKATING RIBBON & SKATING RINK

- No sticks or pucks allowed on Skating Ribbon
- On the ribbon, skate in the same direction
- Helmets are strongly recommended

TOBOGGAN HILL

- Walk up the side of the hill
- Ensure the path is clear before sledding
- Helmets are strongly recommended
- Stay in control at all times
- No outside props or jumps allowed
- No downhill skiing or snowboarding is permitted

OTHER AREAS

- Dog Park, off-leash area, and dog park pond are not open at this time. Anticipated opening is Summer 2021
- Skate Park & Pump Track are not open at this time. Anticipated opening is Summer 2021
- Climbing wall is not open at this time. Anticipated opening is Summer 2021
