



TRAILER SCREENING RULES AND GUIDELINES

Many residents in Harmony may not know the rules around trailer parking in the community. Please use this document as a quick reference guide and refer to your Restrictive Covenant on the title of your lot for any important features particular to your property.

General Rules

As per the Restrictive Covenants, no motorhome, recreation vehicle, boat, truck mounted camper, or camper trailer is allowed on the street or in a driveway for longer than 5 consecutive days, nor more than 6 in aggregate days within a 30 day period unless approved in writing by the OAH.

Parking of commercial (or cargo) trailers on lots, unless fully enclosed, is not permitted.

Front Drive Homes


Permission for parking motorhomes, recreational vehicles, boats, truck mounted campers, or camper trailers for front drive homes can only be obtained through the OAH. These types of vehicles are only permitted on the side of the lot if totally screened and deemed acceptable by the OAH in writing.

Laned Homes

Permission for parking for motorhomes, recreational vehicles, boats, truck mounted campers or camper trailers for laned homes can only be obtained through the OAH. These types of vehicles are only permitted on the side of the lot if screened, and deemed acceptable by the OAH in writing.



RV/Trailer Storage - Front Drive Home Example




