The OAH was created by the Developer to own, operate, and maintain the community elements that are not maintained by Rocky View County.

WHO IS A MEMBER?

An encumbrance is registered on every land title in the community of Harmony, which makes membership a legal obligation.

Annual fees range from \$1500-\$2700 (+GST), depending on the location of your lot, and are subject to change in accordance with the OAH bylaws.
