A 3" X 10" inset bronze plaque contains your custom dedication message, every bench can carry a different story through the words engraved on the customized plaque.

The quoted price will include the custom plaque, installation and administration fees, and maintenance for a 10-year term.

- \$400 Custom Plaque (subject to the cost of engraving)
- \$100 Installation and Administration Fees

**Please Note:**

- The OAH reserves the right to approve the wording and content of the message.
- This program is not to be used for the purpose of advertising or marketing.
- You will be responsible for any loss suffered due to the theft of or vandalism to the plaque.
- A dedication plaque does not give you ownership or any propriety access to the bench themselves; the bench and the plaque will remain the property and responsibility of the OAH.
- At the end of the 10-year term, you will be contacted to determine if you would like to renew the dedication bench. If you choose not to renew, the bench may become available for another person to dedicate a replacement custom plaque.
- Renewal terms may be reduced if no replacement/augmentation of the plaque is needed.
