Harmony Community Garden Regulations

Gardeners must:

- 1. Live in the Harmony community.
- 2. Participate in spring and fall clean-up.
- 3. Conserve water by mulching.
- 4. Not use chemical pesticides or herbicides.
- 5. Restrict crops which grow over 4 ft in height to a maximum row length of 4 ft so as not to shade neighbouring beds.
- 6. Pick produce when it is ripe.
- 7. Only pick produce and/or flowers from their own plot.
- 8. Keep their plot, and paths around their plot, in a clean and orderly condition. Free of weeds, trash, litter, debris, and hazardous materials.
- 9. Clean shared garden tools and return them to the storage shed after use.
- 10. Be responsible for their own garden tools (when brought to the community garden).
- 11. Lock the storage shed after use/before leaving the garden area.
- 12. Agree not to share the shed combination lock code with others.
- 13. Ensure that their guests and children comply with these regulations while at the garden.
